| Description and Indications | An iris expander ring designed to safely expand the iris in order to simplify phacoemulsification, as well as surgeries in which the pupil does not dilate properly using pharmaceuticals. It provides a pupillary opening of 6.3mm and keeps dilation stable during surgery, improving the surgeon's access and field of vision. |
| | 300° semicircular ring with a 60° opening made from a single piece. Does not require an injector. Easy to adapt and remove. The ring can be inserted in incisions smaller than 2 mm. Easy to insert in pupils smaller than 4.5 mm and in shallow chambers. Optimum visibility. Disposable device that cannot be re-sterilized. |
| | Myosis. Coloboma. Traumatic sector iridectomy. Intraoperative floppy iris syndrome. Iris prolapse. Small pupils. Rigid iris tissue due to a pseudoexfoliation. Vitrectomy with small pupils. |
| Material | Medical grade Polymethyl Methacrylate (PMMA). |
| Sterilization method | Ethylene Oxide (ETO). |
| Packaging | Sterile, single unit. |
| Shelf-life | 4.5 years |
